HOTEL INFORMATION

1. **Incidental and room charges** will be turned 'OFF' for your entire stay at the hotel.
 - A credit card will NOT be required at check-in.
 - If you want to charge incidentals to your room, you can change that option by presenting a credit card. A \$30 hold per day will be held on your credit card until the end of your stay.
2. Daily hotel **parking fees** are covered by AAU.
3. **BREAKFAST**
 - will be available at each hotel every morning, starting at 6:00 am. (Normal hours start at 6:30.)
 - Breakfast at Springhill and Fairfield are complimentary. To-go containers will be available from breakfast hostess, if you are wearing your uniform and have your nametag on.
 - Breakfast at Courtyard is not complimentary and is being provided by AAU. Guests staying at Courtyard will be provided with breakfast vouchers. **ONE to-go containers will be available for each guest.**
4. **POOLS**
 - Each hotel has their own pool. Guests can access any pool. Only the Courtyard pool has a bar.
5. **LAUNDRY**
 - Every hotel has multiple laundry rooms available. Washers and dryers can only be used with a credit card. It is 3.50 per wash and 3.50 per dry. Soap and dryer sheets are available for purchase.
 - If you need/want to pay cash, you can obtain a card at the front desk.

HOTEL DEPARTURE INFO

* If you are leaving the hotel on the final day of a session, you **MUST** have all of your things out of your hotel room by the hotel checkout time (usually 11:00 am). You **CANNOT** work matches and then return to the hotel to pack as that will cause an additional hotel room charge. If you are departing on the following day of the finals, you **MUST** be available for the entire finals day.

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<p>REFEREE PRE-TOURNAMENT REGISTRATION (pickup VIK, credential, etc)</p> <p>On June 13, a bus will run from hotel to the convention center, starting at 10 am and will return every half hour. If you have your own car, you can drive to the convention center as there will not be parking charges on that day.</p>	<p>All referees must register in person at the convention center prior to starting your first match. If you do not check-in the day prior to your first scheduled day, you will not be assigned. If you arrive after registration has closed, you should text the general office number to let them know of your arrival time. A bus will run continuously every day from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm, departing the hotel at the top of the hour and departing from the convention center on the half hour. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The bus will stop on the north side at B3, followed by a stop on the south side at A3. 2. A Disney/ESPN mini bus will run every day of the girls sessions from 6:00 am to 10:00 am and from 6:00 pm to 10:00 pm. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - pickup and drop off will be at the 'Globe'. 3. If matches run past the end of bus times, office staff/lead refs will ensure everyone has a ride back to hotel. <p>Parking passes will ONLY be available for referees NOT staying at the Marriott Village.</p> <p>The convention center has limited parking available this year and has restricted the number of passes available for our use.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Referees are welcome to drive your personal vehicle to the convention center, but you must pay for your own parking (\$10) and you will not be reimbursed.
