CHECKING IN

CHECKOUT PROCEDURES

ALL referees must check out of the **first session** by verifying their match counts. If you did not complete the online express checkout form (or the schedule/change request form), you have until 5:00 pm on <u>Sunday June 18</u> to dispute your match counts. After that time, all match counts will be considered final and will not be changed.
