## **SCORESHEETS**

We are having an unusual amount of scoresheets being turned in that do not have all of the information recorded. Please check your scoresheet for its completeness before you turn it in.

## **ROSTERS**

Rosters should be checked by both referees together to avoid errors of non-rostered players playing. The R1 should then initial, date and time the back side of the roster. If there are any numbers that are crossed off, marked through or are changed, a new roster must be obtained by the coach.

A rostered coach MUST be at the table to supervise the work team.

#### REFEREE BEHAVIOR

The rain must be washing away all of our common sense or else we are just too tired to use it. I need to remind all of you that if you are not of legal drinking age, you shouldn't be drinking. Yes, you can have fun, but let's don't let our fun get out of hand. It's much better to spend time in your room than to get in trouble at the pool.

And it is not okay for ANY referee to ask another referee for their phone number while they are on the stand working. Use your off time for personal business.

- \*\* There is a noted shirt of the day. **You MUST wear the shirt**. You cannot just wear a jacket without the shirt of the day under it.
- \*\* If a coach lodges a protest, you should listen to the info and decided if the protest is valid. You can deny the protest. But if the coach disagrees, just call the lead refs and let them address the issue. It is not a mark against you because you allowed the protest.
- \*\* Teams cannot play with 5 players.

#### MATCH STARTING TIMES

The first match of each wave MUST start on time. That means the first match on a court starts at 7:30 am, 8 am or 2:30 pm or 3 pm. Matches may start up to 15 minutes early within the wave, but the first match of the wave must start ON TIME.

If a court is very early, remember the court cannot start without you. Leave the court and go to the championship desk and wait until it is time to start warm-ups, then the coaches will not be bugging you to get started.

## **SANCTIONS**

Only the R1 can issue cards. The R2 can request a card, but cannot issue the sanction. Once a card or a warning is issued, the R1 needs to call the captain over to explain what the card/sanction is. That's the important part. Then allow the captain to return to the coach to explain.
