Things are going great! Continue to pay attention to the details!

- Coaches need an **orange** wristband.
- Only 2 coaches can stand at one time.
- A rostered adult must be at the scoring table at all times during their officiating assignment. They don't have to actively be doing any score table work.
- Spectators cannot be in the bench areas. Cameras and spectators should not be in the area between courts where there are nets.
- Deal with coaches and spectators behavior immediately, You CANNOT wait until the next day to report it. Call your lead or desk referee.
- **If referees are late arriving for their first match, they must sit out that entire match and will not be paid for that match. There is no excuse to be late for your first match.**

We have two more days to go in session 5 and these will be the most important days. The play will get more intense and faster. Please go home and get as much sleep as possible, so you are ready to finish out this session. Those who are habitually late or are no shows will be SENT HOME.

If you have a **protest**, you must be able to explain to the protest committee EXACTLY what you called and EXACTLY what happened. You must tell the protest committee exactly what you said to the captain. You must use the verbiage from the rulebook.
