#### THIRD SESSION

## **SCHEDULE NOTES**

The schedule for tomorrow will be posted very soon. Please note this is only a **DRAFT** version of the schedule. An updated final version will be posted later tonight after we receive an updated grid from the tournament. We will endeavor not to change anyone's start time, but the assignors will text you if your first match time changes. If you are scheduled for 1/2 day (AM or PM) that will not change, so you can feel free to make your plans to sleep in or have dinner with friends.

A few important schedule reminders as we start a new session:

- Please check, re-check, and double-check your schedule every day! We are working to get the preliminary
  schedule out earlier each day, but that means there will more than likely be changes. Check before you go to
  bed...and check again when you wake up the next morning. We only send individual communications if your first
  match time changes or if there is a change after matches have started for that day.
- Change Request Forms must be submitted **two days** prior to your requested change (you have until midnight tonight to make a request for Saturday, June 22). Please ensure your request is clear and concise. For example, a good request is, "I would like to work AM only on Saturday, June 22, and my friends DongJ, Sintop, and Cayetano would like to work AM only as well."
  - These are NOT good requests, "If I have to work any half days, please make them mornings." OR "I would like a half day on this day."
- If you want to ensure you are off the same time as your friends, you must submit a Change Request Form for a specific date and a list of everyone wanting to be off for AM or PM on that day. Otherwise you will be assigned your 1/2 day according to the needs of the tournament.

- After the schedule is published each day (including tomorrow), it is TOO LATE to make a request! Please do not submit a Change Request stating that your schedule for tomorrow is not what you hoped for and asking for a change. Those forms are ignored.
- However, if we previously confirmed a request and you find your schedule is incorrect, please text the assigning
  phone (830-444-6069) or email <u>aauvolleyballrefinfo@gmail.com</u> immediately, and we will do our best to correct it.
  We work very hard to track everyone's requests and ensure that they are fulfilled if at all possible, but sometimes
  things get lost.
- Referees may not give matches to each other or take matches from each other. Any scheduling
  changes must be approved through your desk referee or lead referee. Referees who work matches
  without authorization are considered "volunteers" and will not be paid for those matches.
