## ROSTERS

- Referees **MUST** check the roster (and initial, date and time the back of the copy).
- Coaches **MUST** have a copy of their roster and must initial before you initial. The team cannot play without a roster.
  - Matches cannot be held up for coach that must go get their roster.

## SCHEDULES

- Pay attention to your match times. There might not be a break between the wave on your court. Late arrivals to matches are no longer acceptable. You will be replaced and you will not receive a replacement match.
- Check, check and recheck your schedules, especially in the morning as there could have been some changes overnight. Individual notices will **NOT** be sent out unless your start time changes.

## REMINDERS

1. Better to **be early** for the bus than to miss it. If you miss the west bus, you can also get on the north/south bus and walk across the street to the west, but it's a long walk.
2. A **rostered adult must be at the table** to monitor the work team for the entire match.
3. No more than 2 coaches should be standing at one time.
4. Time Management - as soon as the match is finished, start the next match warm-ups, then complete the scoresheet.
5. Do not call the general phone for court issues. Use the phone number for your section.
6. Do not call or text the assigning phone for court issues. Use the phone number for your section.
7. Cell phone use is **NOT ALLOWED** while on the stand or during timeouts.
8. Artificial noisemakers are **NOT** allowed.
9. Check, check, check and double check your officiating assignments. If you want a paper copy, stop by the officials office.
10. Keep all cameras **off the court!**

## SCORESHEET REMINDERS

1. You can only take scoresheets if you are headed directly to your court. No stopping in the bathroom or the officials lounge.
2. Scoresheets **must be returned immediately** after the completion of the sheets you have. If scoresheets are not returned, you could be limited to only one.
3. Check the scoresheet thoroughly before signing it. Cross reference match scores against the final service rounds and running score column. (I had at least 2 reports today of inverted winning/losing te
4. Do the coin flip before checking rosters. Check the rosters during warm-ups. Do not delay the start of

the match.

5. You **MUST WRITE** your names on the scoresheet (**BEFORE**) the match starts.

### **REFEREE LOUNGE**

1. The referee lounge should be a place where referees can relax between matches. If you want to be loud and party, you should go downstairs to the food area or outside of the referee lounge. If you are on the phone, keep your conversation to yourself or go outside of ref room.
2. Do not touch other referees' belongings or food. If you didn't bring it, you should not touch it. There is a microwave in the north officials office and in the south officials lounge.

### **FOREIGN GUEST OFFICIALS**

If you **do not live** in the United States and need to be paid by check, you **MUST** complete a W-8 form tomorrow and return it to N322. We are working on the payments for the first session and I **NEED** your form immediately.

### **SHIRT EXCHANGES**

I ordered shirts after most of you had registered. So most of you should have the correct sizes, if YOU entered your size correctly. I do have a few extra shirts, but not many. So we will try and make exchanges after noon tomorrow.
